- This fee compensates our fantastic instructors and allows TVS to provide overhead support to our programs.
- Some programs have a materials surcharge. If applicable, the reason for the surcharge is listed in the “Fee” column in the chart above. (The materials surcharge for community partners might also include transportation costs incurred in bringing instructors to our campus, equipment rentals, specialized consumable supplies, etc.)
- No-fee programs and lower-fee programs are made possible through the generosity of TVS Faculty members and donors!

REGISTRATION TIPS + PAYMENT INFORMATION

- ALL PROGRAMS begin after Martin Luther King, Jr. Day.
 - Please pay special attention to the specific dates of the programs. Some programs do not begin until the week of March 20.
 - *If you see an expected date “missing,” this indicates either a no-school day OR a day the instructor is unavailable. These are not mistakes!*
- Registration for MOST programs will occur online, via the CampBrain system.
 - Registration opens on **Wednesday, January 4, 2023, at 5:00 p.m.** (unless otherwise noted).
 - Some programs have an **external** registration method. Please see the bolded notes in the chart above!
- Several programs will have limited enrollment (*denoted in the chart above*).
 - When enrollment fills, CampBrain will automatically switch the program status to “waitlisting.” You are welcome to add your child’s name to the waitlist, or find other programs that are still open.
 - If space opens in a waitlisted program, the Auxiliary Programs Team will contact you as soon as possible to inquire about finalizing enrollment.
- A 15-minute supervised break for restroom, water, and snack (provided) will occur between school-day dismissal and the start of enrichment programs.
- Trinity Valley School is not responsible for weather-related cancellations. Whereas we certainly try to minimize these last-minute cancellations, we appreciate your understanding if / when they occur!
